**What are we offering?** *Court reservation, lessons and group clinics.*

**Reservation and payment:** *We encourage patrons to make purchases/reservations using credit or debit cards. You must have a court reservation or have signed up previously for a drill or lesson to enter the facility. Please book your spot time reservation online if possible [www.rockcreektennis.com](http://www.rockcreektennis.com)*

*Payment will be taken at the time of reservation. Court reservation can be made by calling (202) 722-5949 (7) days in advance.*

*If using household credit, please call the front desk at (202) 722-5949 to apply to the reservation or activity 24 hours in advance.*

**What to Expect:**

- *100% mandatory temperature checks and screening for entry.*
- *All patrons are always required to wear a face covering in the facility- including while actively engaged in play on the courts (Indoor Bubble). They must remain in place and cover both the nose and mouth to be considered effective. We encourage patrons to stay home if they are not feeling well.*
- *Hand sanitizer will be available by each court (by the net)*
- *Patrons will wait until 5 minutes prior to their scheduled court time to enter the facility and proceed to check-in following social distancing markers.*
- *Patrons will not be allowed to congregate in any area of the facility. Limited number of players per court.*
- *RCTC will not provide bench and chairs inside the bubble in order to prevent gatherings.*
- ***Only one parent/guardian allowed with child at the facility but no congregating around courts/lobby (if child is in a lesson then the parent should wait in their car). Only players will be allowed inside the tennis bubble. Upon drop off, parents or care givers must remain on the back-parking lot inside their vehicle.***

- *Try to stay at least six feet apart from other players. Do not make physical contact with them (such as shaking hands or a high five).*
- *Use your racquet/foot to pick up balls and hit them to your opponent. Avoid using your hands to pick up the balls.*
- *Stay on your side of court. Avoid changing ends of the court.*
- *Remain apart from other players when taking a break.*
- *If a ball from another court comes to you, send it back with a kick or with your racquet.*
- *Restroom usage will be limited on how many people can access at one time.*
- *Heightened cleaning procedures per CDC guidelines will be followed. Staff will clean and disinfect all surface areas every hour (counter tops, door handles, railings, computer screen, keyboard, credit card machine). The restroom will also be cleaned and disinfected at least every two hours.*
- *Leave the court as soon as reasonably possible.*
- *Wash your hands thoroughly or use a hand sanitizer after coming off the court.*
- *Do not use the locker room or changing area. Shower at home.*
- *No extra-curricular or social activity should take place. No congregation after playing.*
- *All players should leave the facility immediately after play.*

*The Rock Creek Tennis Center will continue to follow CDC, NPS and local health department guidelines and will open additional programs when it is deemed safe and the proper measures to protect the tennis community are in place. The Rock Creek Tennis Center will be strictly enforcing the safety guidelines. Patrons that cannot adhere to or follow the guidelines will be asked to leave. They have been put in place for your protection and must be adhered to by all tennis center visitors.*
